Please Join Pisgah Presbyterian on Saturday, February 15, for the 2014 Pisgah Academy. They have invited Rev. Gaston Warner, Executive Director of ZOE International, to return to Kentucky to be the keynote speaker.

Those of you who heard him speak last October in Lexington will recall that he talked about "dead aid" – well-intentioned but misguided charity. Gaston has recommended the book, Toxic Charity, by Robert Lupton, as our text. We want to continue our focus on building compassionate communities, but we also want to insure that our compassion is effective – that our help does not hurt.

We will also have a local focus on hunger in Woodford County. Gary Jones will lead that discussion from his perspective with the Woodford Ministerial Association Soup Kitchen and his work with the Woodford County Food Pantry.

WOODFORD COUNTY FARM-TO-FOOD BANK

Woodford County has recently approved a cost-share request to participate in the Farm-to-Food Bank program which pays farmers for produce which is not sold at the regular Farmer's Market. This program benefits: 1) those people who are served by the food bank by providing fresh fruits and vegetables not otherwise available; 2) the farmers, by giving them some payment for the surplus produce; and 3) the entire food system by reducing the amount of wasted food.
