From the Trustees: Use of Endowment Fund - Proposal Deadline



Midway Christian is very fortunate to have an Endowment Fund which was established in August of 2007 through the generous gift from Dorothy Gordon. As stated in the Endowment Fund Policy, the primary purpose of the Fund is "to expand the witness and mission of Jesus Christ, serving human needs in our community and around the world." In keeping with this purpose, the policy allows an annual withdrawal for outreach-related improvements, equipment or programs. The trustees will be meeting the

first of June to explore options of making such funds available again this year for such projects. If the trustees decide that funds are available, they are asking that written requests from the congregation (for outreach projects which are not already included in the church annual budget) be submitted by **May 18th, 2014**. The requests will be reviewed by the Trustees who will make recommendations to the Midway Christian Church Board, which will have the final approval of the projects funded.

As we continue to live out our vision of becoming a more Christ-Centered, welcoming community of faith, we realize that part of achieving this vision is becoming better stewards of the generous and plentiful gifts and resources that God blesses us with as people of faith. The Admin Committee is asking that everyone please place their estimated giving cards in the offering plate on Consecration Day, **May 18th**, as a sign of our commitment and our response to God's grace that has been shown to us as children of God.
