

#### **Endowment Fund News**


In April, the church received another installment from Betty Ann's estate for the Endowment Fund of Midway Christian Church. The Trustees decided to invest the majority of these funds in our Vanguard account while using some of the funds for various projects around the church and parsonage. The projects include replacing the ceiling tiles in the fellowship hall and replacing the carpet in the parsonage basement due to flooding issues.

The Trustees also decided to increase the principle of the Mission Outreach Endowment Fund by 2%, raising it from \$103,722 to \$105,796.

The Trustees will meet in May to review the requests for grants from the Mission Outreach Endowment Fund. The Trustees will share their decisions at the June Board meeting.


