Gala in the Garden Evening

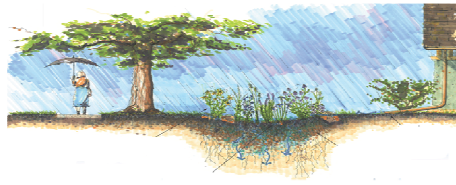
